Before Mounting

1. Download the App

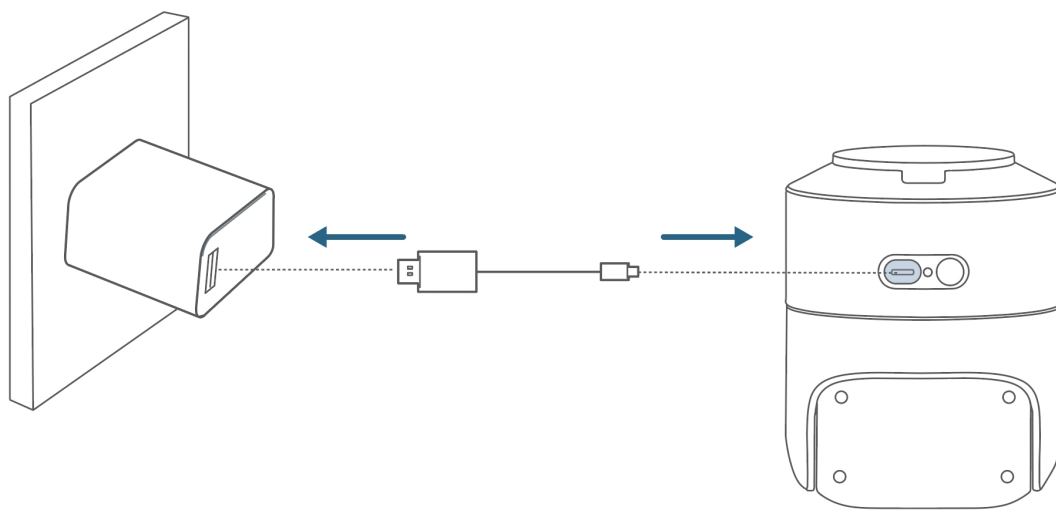
- ① Download the latest version of eufy app.
- ② Log in or create a new account.



2. Fully Charge the Camera Before First Use

 The device must be powered by a regulated, constant 5 V supply. Using any other fast-charging adapter may cause damage to the device.

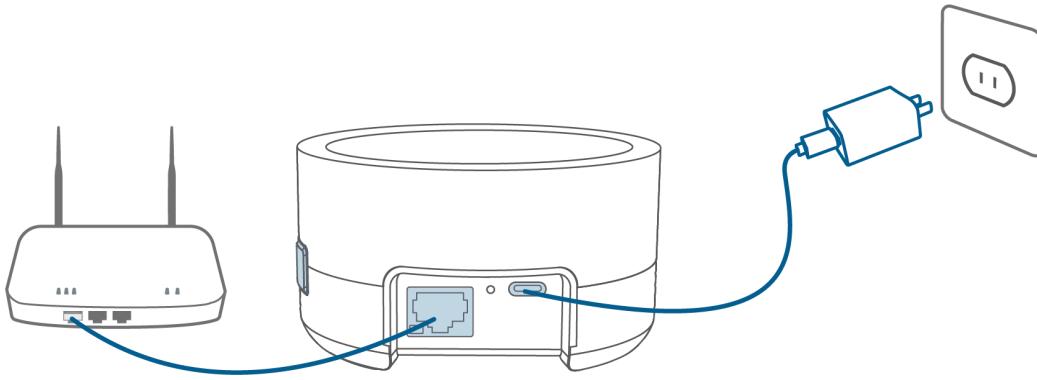
Charge the camera with the provided USB-C cable until the blue light turns off (about 4 hours with a 5V/2A power adapter).



 You can check the battery level in the app.

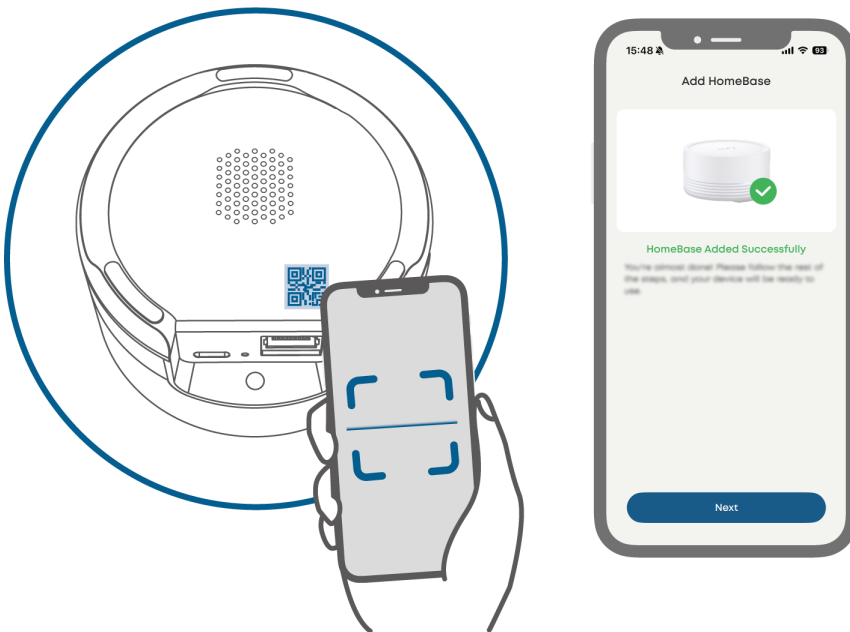
3. Add HomeBase Mini (Optional)

① Power the HomeBase Mini with the included 5V/2A power adapter and then connect it to your router. Wait about one minute until the blue light blinks slowly.



 To ensure proper operation, use only the included original power adapter. If a non-original adapter must be used, it must be rated at 5V/2A or higher to avoid insufficient power supply.

② Open the eufy app, scan the QR code on the HomeBase Mini. Then follow the in-app instructions to add the device.

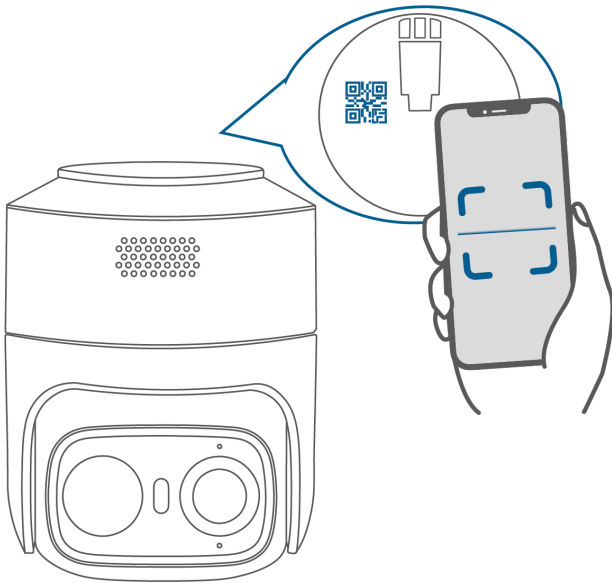


 During this process, ensure the network is stable and the HomeBase is powered on. A solid blue light indicates a successful binding.

LED Indicator	Description
Red Light Blinks Slowly	Powered on, not connected to network
Blue Light Blinks Slowly	Powered on, connected to network
Solid Blue light	Successfully bound
Solid Red light	HomeBase Mini offline / network disconnected

4. Add the Camera

Open the eufy app, tap **Add Device** and scan the QR code on the camera. Then follow the in-app instructions to add the device.



Option 1: Connect to your Router (Without HomeBase Mini)

Tap **Connect to Router** and then follow the in-app instructions.

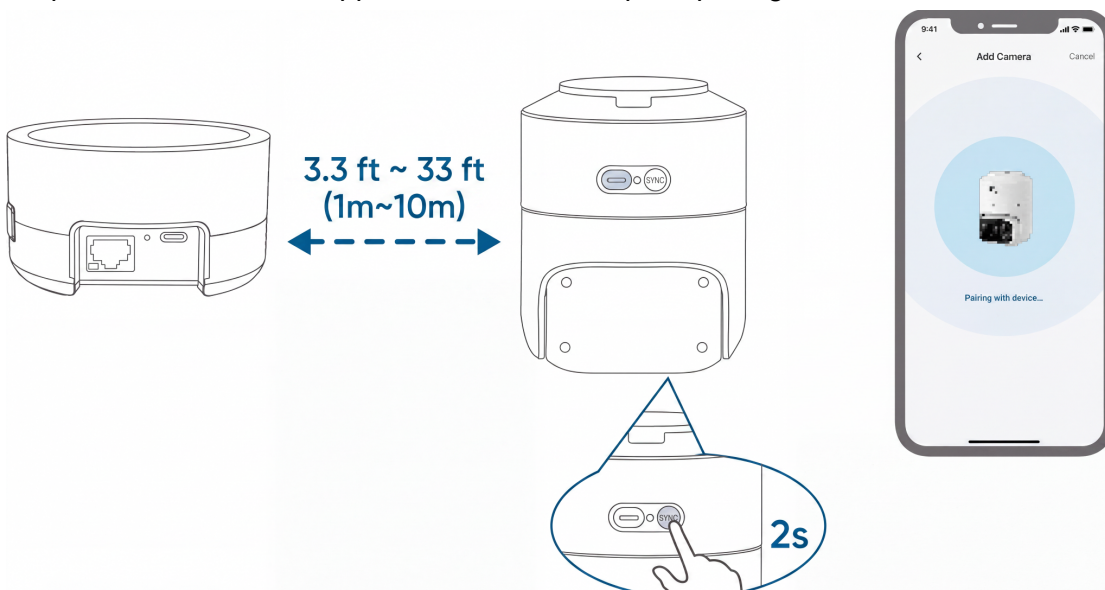
💡 The device only supports 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network.

Option 2: Connect to HomeBase Mini

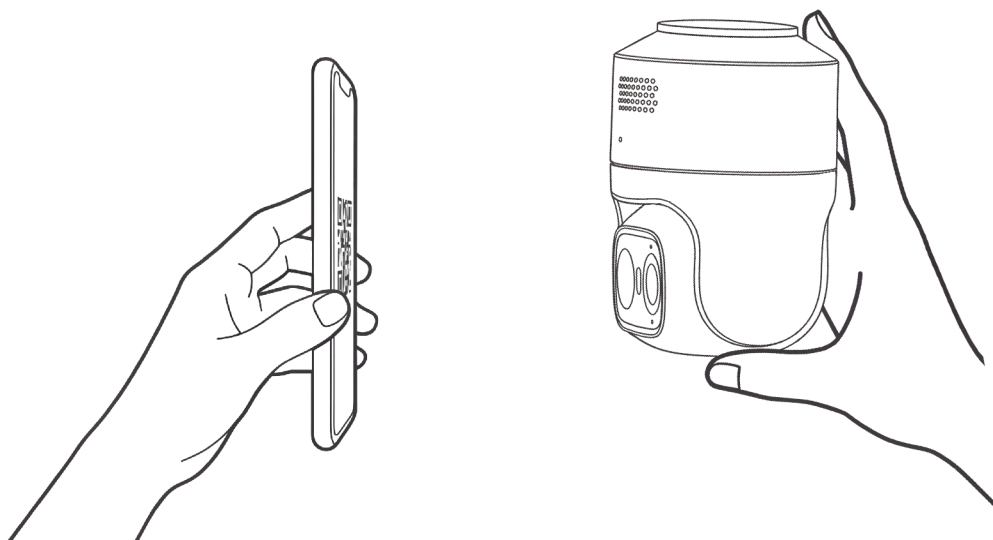
💡 Some features, e.g., local bionic self-learning facial recognition, storage management, and cross-camera tacking, require your eufyCam to be connected to the HomeBase.

① Tap **Connect to HomeBase**.

② Press and hold the camera's SYNC button for about 2 seconds until the blue light blinks slowly with a beep. Then follow the in-app instructions to complete pairing.



When prompted, point the camera at the QR code on your phone screen to complete pairing.
*Keep your phone screen on during scanning.



5. Expand the Storage (Optional)

1. Insert the microSD Card

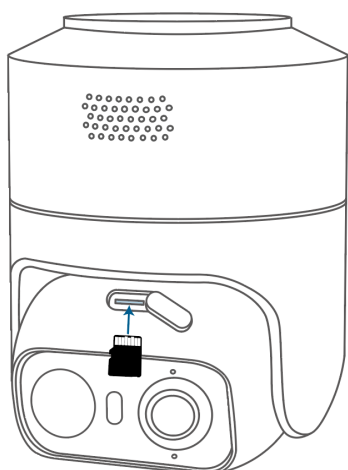
Insert the microSD card (high-speed recommended) with its pins facing **UP**. Press the card into the slot until it clicks into position.

Refer to the table below for recommended microSD card specifications for different usage scenarios.

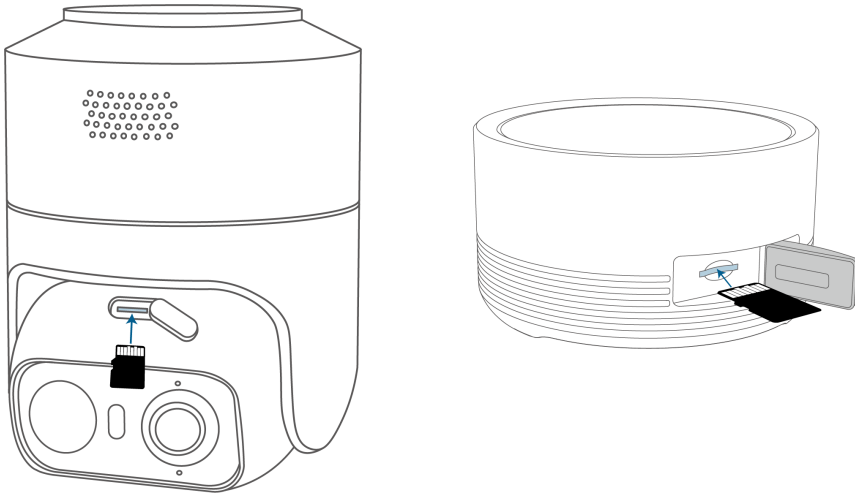
- Without a HomeBase Mini or microSD card, the camera cannot store recordings.
- Once inserted, the microSD card will serve as the primary storage medium, prioritizing the storage of system-generated data (such as logs and configuration files) and video recordings from the cameras.
- The microSD card must be formatted in the eufy app before using it to store the encrypted recordings.

- Without HomeBase Mini: Insert the microSD card (up to 256GB) into the camera.



- With HomeBase Mini: Insert the microSD card (up to 1TB) into HomeBase Mini.

 Do not insert or remove the microSD card when HomeBase Mini is powered on.



2. Remove the microSD Card

To remove the microSD card, press it in to release, then pull it out.

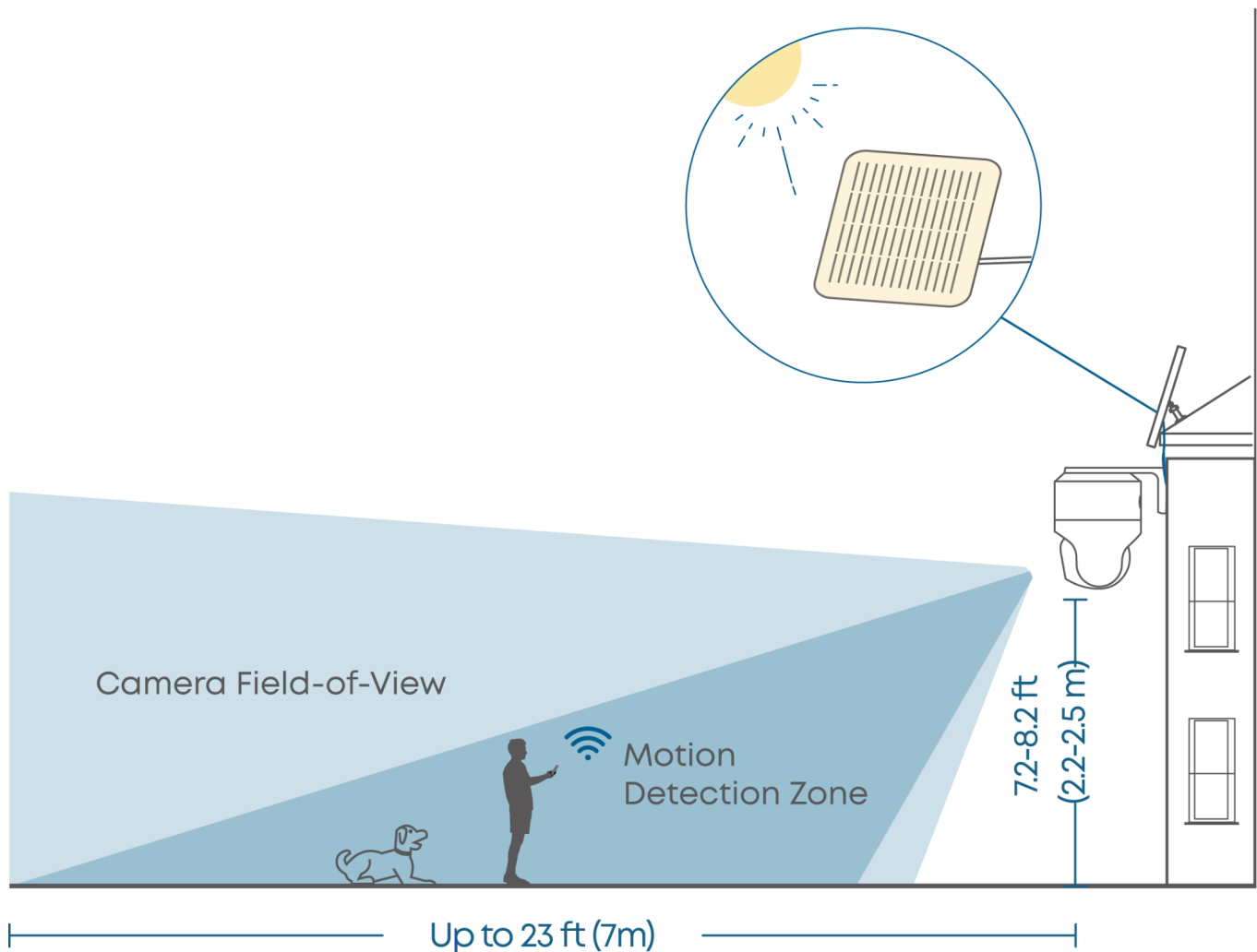
Mounting the Camera

 To prevent network interference, maintain a minimum distance of 1 m (3.3 ft) between the camera, HomeBase, and router.

1. Choose a Location

Recommended Location:

- Height of between 2.2 m to 2.5 m (7.2 ft to 8.2 ft)
- 7 m (23 ft) field of view
- Strong Wi-Fi signal



 A greater downward tilt angle of the camera reduces the blind spot range, but also decreases the motion detection range.



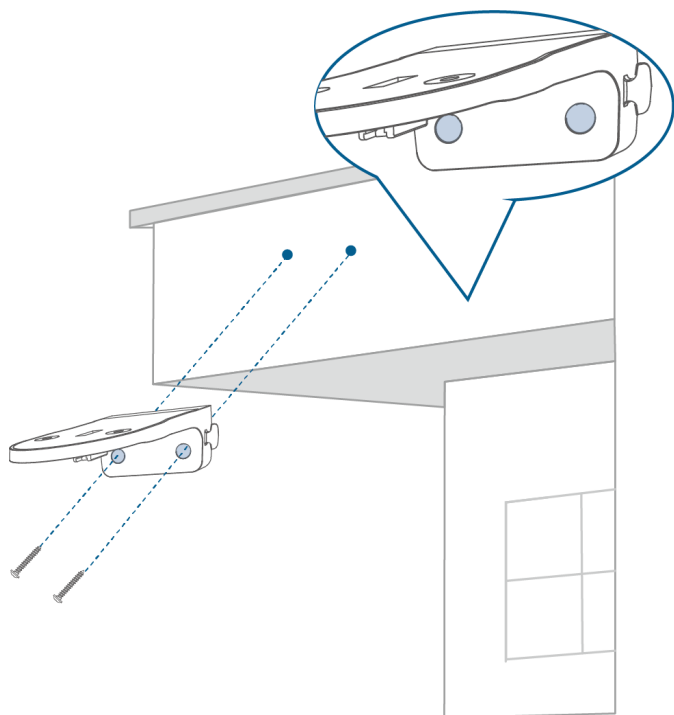
- 
- To avoid missed detections, install the cameras at an angle rather than directly facing the monitoring area.
 - Do not place the camera lens close to walls or glass surfaces to prevent infrared (IR) reflections from the LED.
 - Do not point the camera directly at swaying trees, roads with passing vehicles or pedestrians, or areas with a light source within 0.5 m (1.6 ft).

2. Install the Mounting Bracket

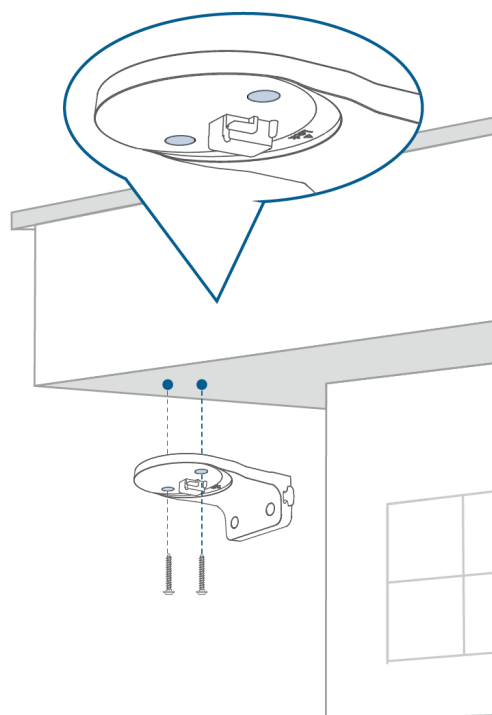
This bracket can be installed either way — just attach the side with 2 holes to the wall or the top.



Do not install the bracket in any manner other than as described in the manual. Improper installation may result in the camera falling.



Wall Mounting



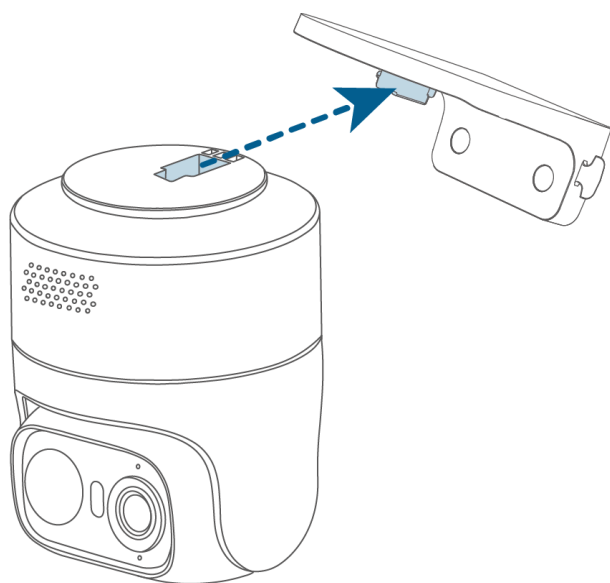
Top Mounting

3. Mount the Camera

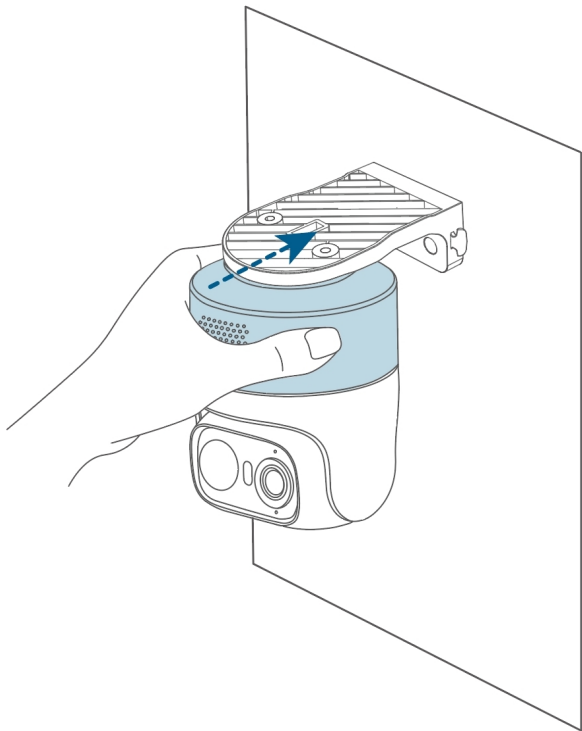


The camera is designed for inverted installation only. Upright installation may cause water ingress.

- ① Attach the Camera to the Mounting Bracket

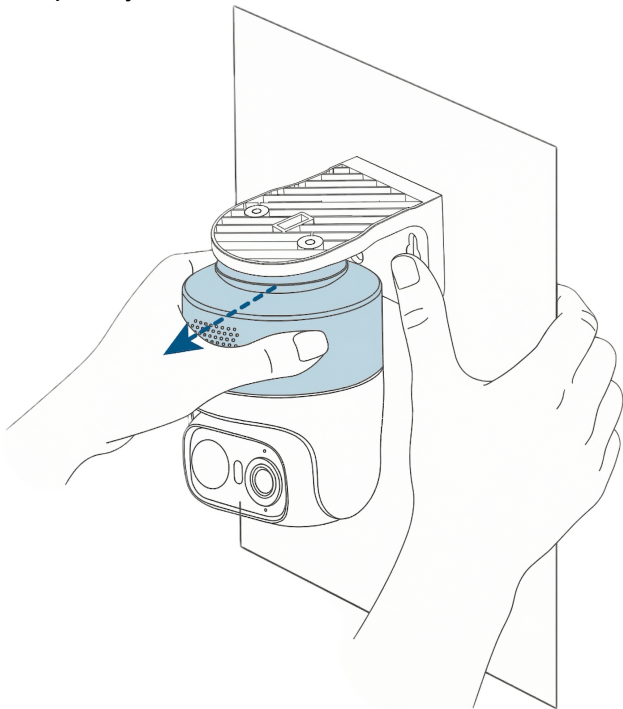


② Slide to Lock the Camera



To remove the camera from the bracket:

Hold the bracket with one hand, and pull the camera straight out away from the bracket until it detaches completely.



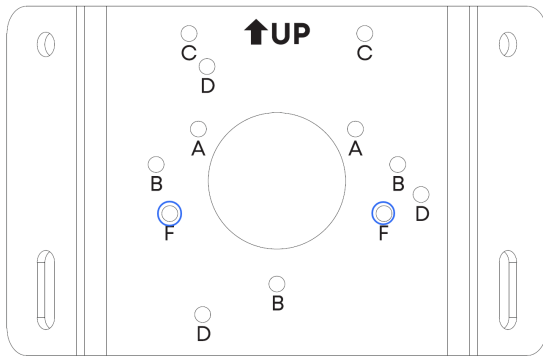
Install with Corner Mount Bracket (Optional)

Use the corner mount bracket when installing the camera on the corner.

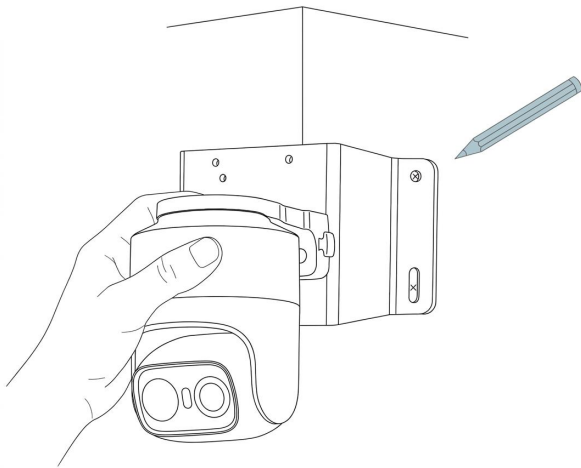
① Use the included screws (M3.5*10mm) to mount the camera bracket onto the corner mount bracket.



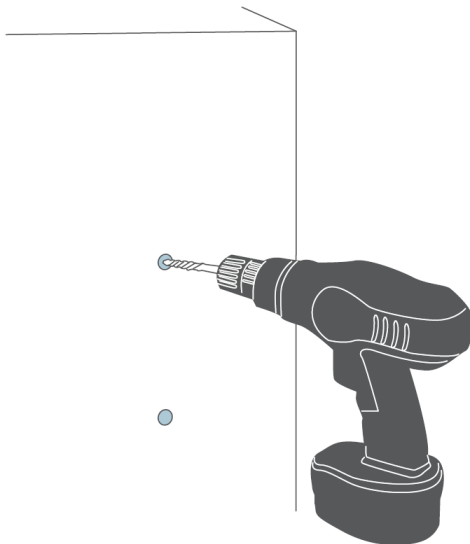
Keep the "UP" sign upward and align the mounting hole with the F hole.



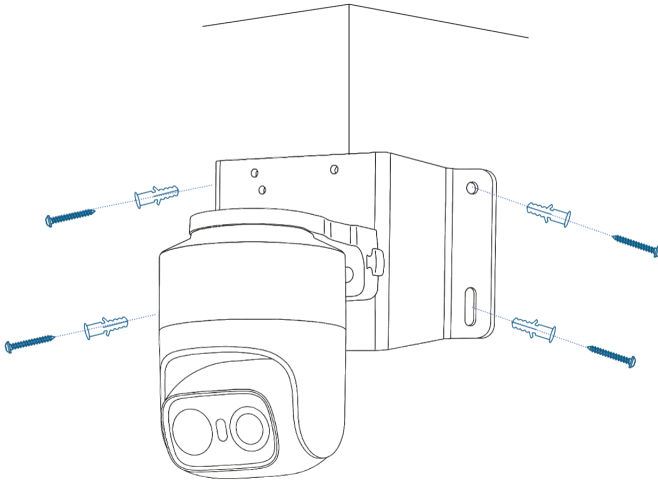
② Select a spot with enough distance from the top, and mark the drilling points.



③ Drill the holes with a power drill.

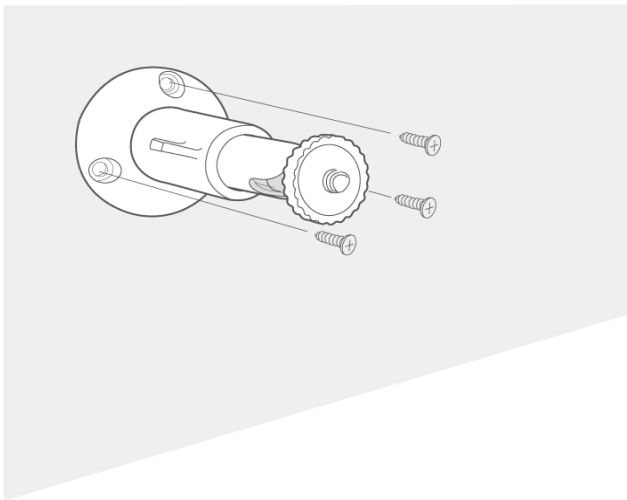


- ④ Use the included screws (PAB3.5*30mm) to attach the bracket to the wall.



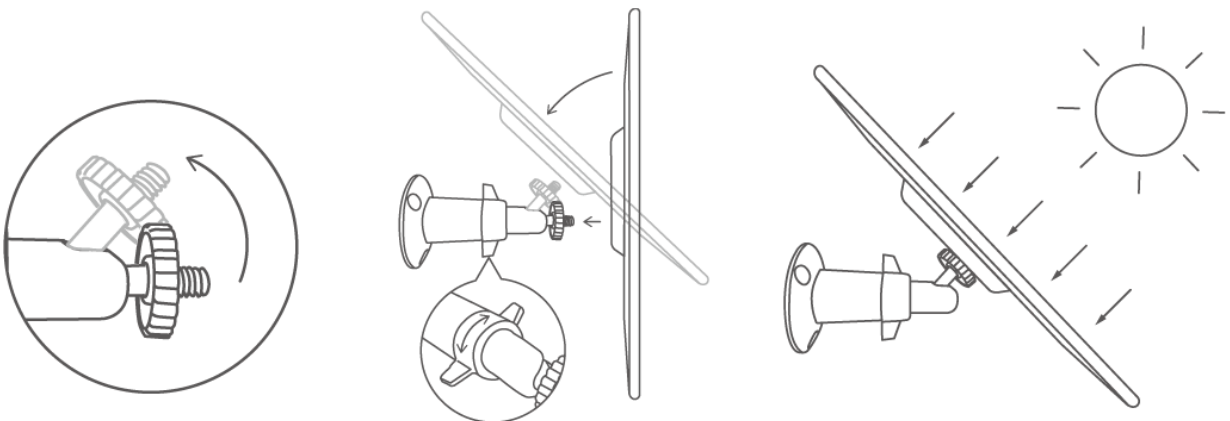
4. Mount the Solar Panel (Optional)

1. Choose an installation location with maximum sunlight and minimal shade from leaves, trees, or structures.
2. Install the solar panel mounting bracket.

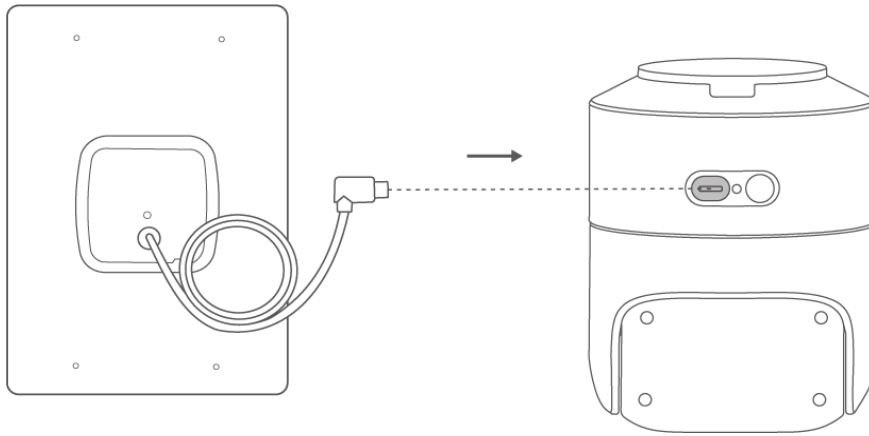


3. Attach the solar panel to the bracket. Loosen the adjustment knob, face the solar panel toward the equator, set the desired tilt angle, and then tighten securely.

💡 You can use a website like sunsolar tilt.com/calculator or similar app to determine the optimal angle for your location. It is recommended to adjust the tilt angle by season.



4. Connect the solar panel cable to the camera.

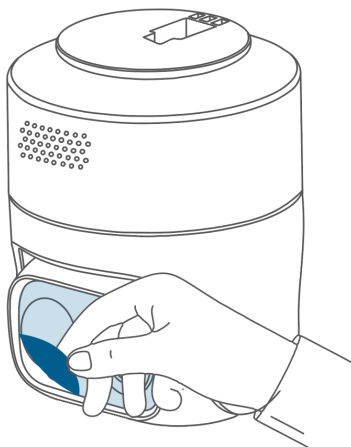


After Mounting

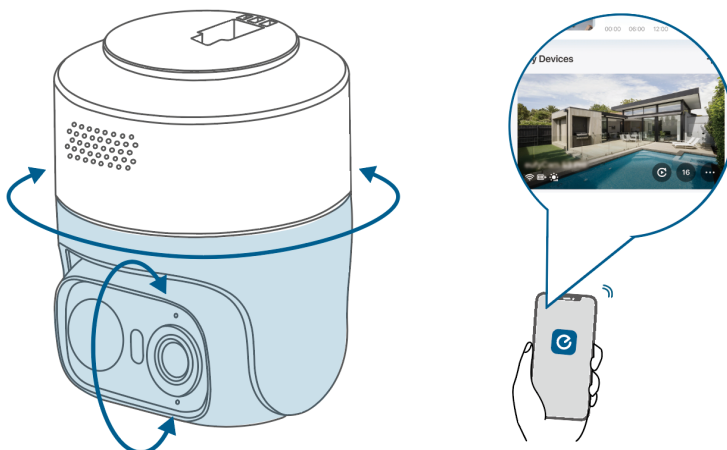
1. Adjust the Camera Field of View

 There is a risk of the camera freezing and failing to rotate under extreme rain or snow conditions.

1. Remove the protective film.



2. Rotate the camera via eufy app to get the optimal angle.



2. Set a Preset Position

Set a preset position in the eufy app. Otherwise, rotating the camera may change the default preset, preventing it from returning to the intended position after tracking ends.

Control the Camera in the App

View Live Footage

Tap the target device in the Home page to enter the Live Stream page.
You can view live footage in real time and access “Record”, “Sound”, “Night Vision”, and other quick controls.

Adjust the Camera Angle

1. Tap “Pan-tilt” at the bottom of the Live Stream page.
2. Adjust the direction of the camera or apply a preset to obtain the desired field of view.
3. Use “Round Look” or “Calibration” if needed.

Turn on AI Tracking

Tap “AI Tracking” to let the camera automatically detect and follow the moving objects.

Trigger an Alarm

1. Tap the “Alarm” icon in the upper-right corner of the Live Stream page.
2. Select an alarm mode.
3. Tap “Confirm”.

Set Motion Detection

Tap the “Settings” icon in the upper-right corner of the Live Stream page and select “Motion Detection” to enter the Motion Detection page.

You can configure how the camera detects and responds to movement.

Set an Activity Zone

1. (Optional) Tap “Go to setting” in the Current Activity Zone to set a preset position.
2. Tap “Activity Zone” > “+” to draw a frame you want to monitor.



Once set, only motion within the selected area will trigger alerts.

Select Detection Types

Select the object types to detect in the Motion Detection page.

Set a Preset Position

1. Tap the “Settings” icon in the upper-right corner of the Live Stream page.
2. Select “Pan-tilt Settings” to enter the Pan-tilt Settings page.
3. Tap “Preset Positions”, adjust the field of view, and then tap “Set” to set a position.

Add Privacy Zones

1. Tap the “Settings” icon in the upper-right corner of the Live Stream page.
2. Select “Video Settings” > “Privacy Zones” to enter the Privacy Zones page.
3. Tap “Add Privacy Zones” to define specific areas that should be blocked from recording or live viewing.

Turn on / off the Status LED

1. Tap the “Settings” icon in the upper-right corner of the Live Stream page.
2. Select “General” to enter the General page.
3. Turn on / off the “Status LED”.

 The Status LED is off by default and only applies to live streaming and recording. When enabled in the app, the red light stays on only during these activities; when disabled, the light remains off.

Manage Smart Configuration

Tap “Smart” at the bottom of the Home page.
You can configure modes and automation settings.

Set a Security Mode

1. Select the target device in the “Modes” tab.
2. Select the security mode - Home, Away, and Disarmed.
You can also customize the security mode.

Create a Schedule

1. Select the target device in the “Modes” tab.
2. Tap the “Settings” icon in the Schedule block.
3. Follow the in-app instructions to set a schedule, and then tap “Save”.
You can also tap “+” to add more schedules.

Create an Automation

You can create automations triggered by motion, schedules, or device status to control camera actions or other devices.

1. Tap “Automation” > “Add Automation”.
2. Follow the in-app instructions to set an automation, and then tap “Save”.
